





Frequently Asked Questions



What does the Classic Analog Bass Preamp do?

The Classic Preamp delivers a wide range of authentic Ampeg tones in a compact pedal.

How is the Classic Preamp powered?

The Classic Preamp is powered by either a standard 9V battery or the optional AC adapter.

How do I change the battery in my pedal?

Unscrew the four screws on the bottom of the pedal to access the battery.

My bass sounds weak through the pedal. What's up?

This is often due to a dying battery. Try changing your battery or plugging in the optional AC adapter. You may also want to check your cables and instrument.

My pedal works in bypass, but there is no signal when it's turned on.

Check to ensure that the optional AC adapter or battery has the correct voltage and/or polarity. Ensure that your cables are plugged into the correct input/output jacks.

Can I use my USA-bought Classic Preamp overseas?

Yes. You will need to either use batteries, or purchase the proper AC adapter for the country you will be using it in.

What is the output of the Classic Preamp's optional power supply? 9V DC, plug is center Negative.













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Can I plug headphones into my Classic Preamp?

This is not recommended. Most headphones have a very high impedance. You will in all likelihood not get the results you are looking for.

Can I use my (Brand X) AC adapter with my Classic Preamp?

Yes, as long as the output is 9 Volts DC and the plug is center Negative. The current should be 100ma or higher.

Can I use the Classic Preamp in my Effects Loop?

Typically the Classic Preamp is best used between your bass and the input of your amplifier but it can also be used in an effects loop.

Can I use the Classic Preamp to drive a power amp?

Yes, absolutely. The Classic Preamp outputs a line-level signal comparable to most other preamps.

Can I connect the Classic Preamp directly into a mixing console?

Yes, you sure can!

Does the Classic Preamp have "True Bypass" switching?

Yes.

Can I plug the Classic Preamp in between my amp head and my cabinet?

No. The Classic Preamp should only be connected to the input or effects loop of your amplifier,

How long will my battery last?

The Classic Preamp has a minimal current draw, so a fresh battery should last around 8-10 hours.

My active bass is overloading the input of the Classic Preamp.

On the inside of your pedal is a jumper that you can move to pad your input down by 15db. Unscrew the four screws from the bottom of the pedal to access the jumper. Pins 1-2 are used for normal operation. Move the jumper to Pins 2-3 for 15db pad.
